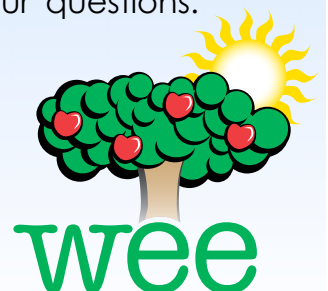

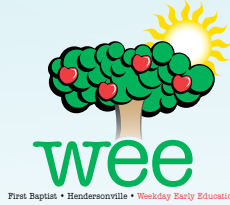

## children's ministry

Checkpoint is here!



Checkpoint kiosks are conveniently located on each floor. During check-in parents receive a nametag providing your child's name, location, current allergy information and a unique code provided solely for your child on that given day. It prints out a security tag for preschoolers. Please check the information about your child and if corrections are needed, proceed to the Children's Center Lobby or contact Lora at 693-3493.

If more than one caregiver will be picking up children, it is possible for you to print more than one security tag. After placing the nametag on your child, escort them to their classroom where you will find a sign in sheet to record important information needed. **A cell phone number must be given upon drop-off in the event of an emergency.**

This security tag has a code that matches that of your child(ren). At the time of pick up, present the tag of your preschool child(ren) to their leader where they will take it and match it to the code on your child's nametag. If you have 2 or more children, and only one security tag, have the leader initial the security tag then move on to the next location. When making your last pick up, you will then turn in your security tag to that leader. For a preschool child to be picked up, the security tag must be presented. In the event you do not have one, you will be asked to present your drivers license and it will be coordinated with the information you provided.
