BUILDING BRIDGES

Doing construction work at Crosswalk? Gardening at Crosswalk? That's right! Each Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday afternoon our Crosswalk volunteers are doing life construction and soul-gardening during the after school program. It is a real joy to watch! Here are some recent examples:



- Walking into the Middle School snack room last week, I noticed a volunteer receiving hugs from several middle school girls. At the same time, her husband was making excuses for getting beaten at a game of ping pong with a student.
- Next, I wandered into the gym. There I noticed one of our student ministers gasping for air while playing a game of basketball with several high school students. Meanwhile a female gym attendant sat on the floor surrounded by young girls "yappin" away! As I left the gym a young man was being corrected for kicking a basketball across the gym floor.
- From there I ventured into the high school snack room. Here I observed a "pool hustlin" deacon shooting a game of 8 Ball with a student. The female volunteer circulated throughout the room sharing some of her fresh homemade cookies with the high school students.
- Next, I strolled upstairs and watched 3 volunteers tutoring students with their homework. Another volunteer taught guitar lessons to two students in another room.
- Arriving back downstairs I witnessed volunteers helping 3 or 4 students memorize a Bible verse so they could earn .60 cents for a snack.



• The next day a gym volunteer was seen talking to a young high school girl about Jesus. He gave her several books by Josh McDowell and Lee Stroble to help her with questions and doubts. About an hour later, one of our security staff gave a Bible to a student because he told him that he didn't own one.

Crosswalk volunteers are building bridges. They are building relational bridges of trust. These bridges are being used by God to plant seeds of his love which God will grow and bring to fruition in His timing. Because of the smaller attendance, there are more and more opportunities to build these bridges. "Let us not become weary in doing good, for in due season we will reap a harvest if we don't give up". Please come help us build bridges and plant seeds.
